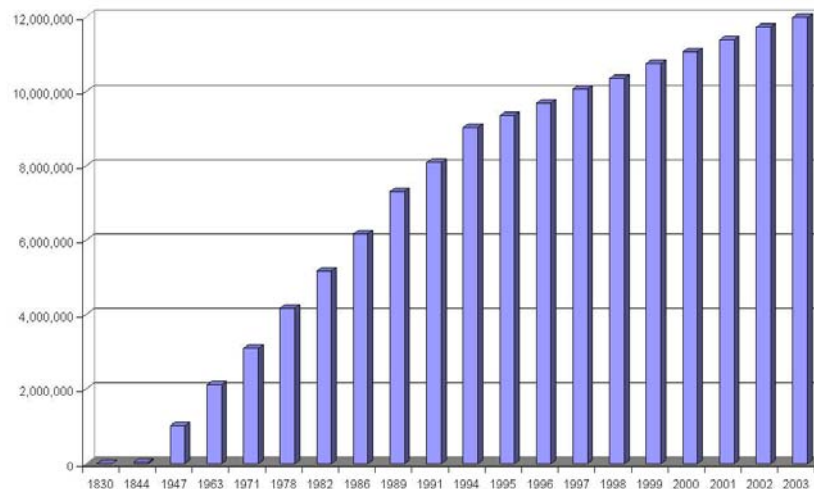

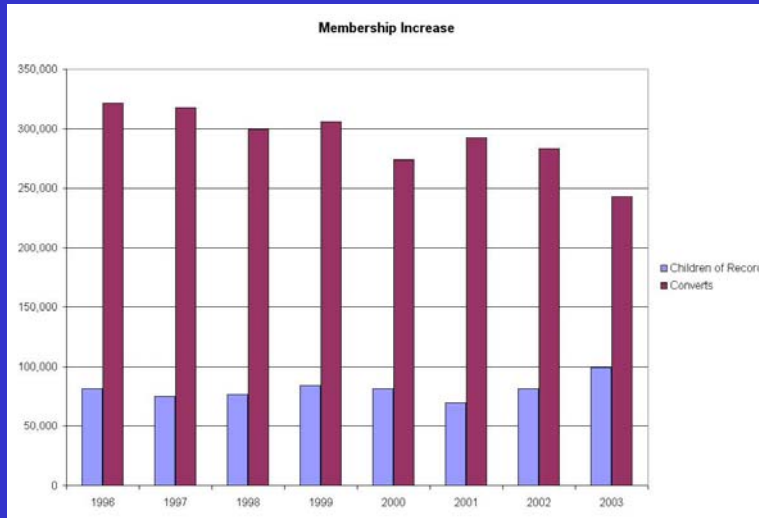
LDS Membership Statistics

Increase in New Members

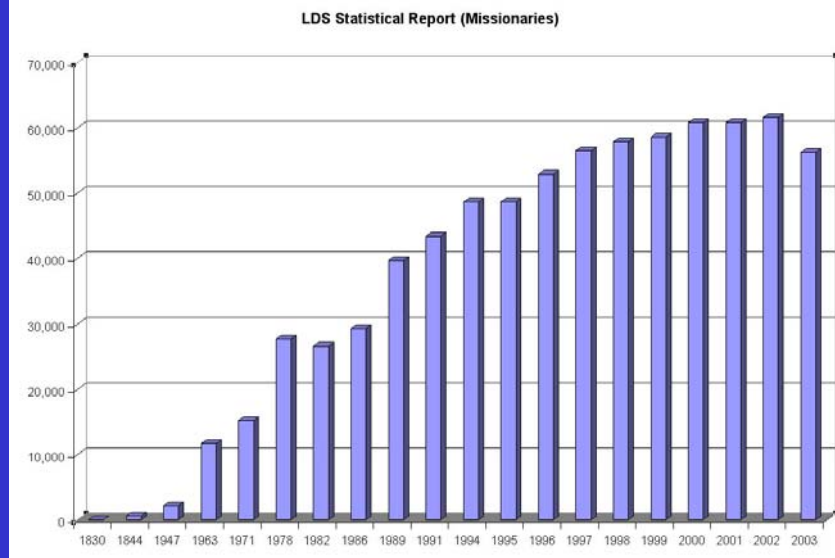

LDS Missionaries in the Field



Missionary Methods



- Missionary Training Center
 - Trained on how to present the 6 discussion topics and not to stray from them
 - Language training if going to a foreign country
- The Mormon Faith is Based on Feelings
 - Subjective “Testimony” or feeling that a teaching or practice is true
 - Distrust anything not Mormon

Missionary Methods (Cont.)



- Contacts with “Investigators”:
 - Mormon acquaintance gives the missionaries your name and address
 - Neighborhood “tracting”
 - Response to TV/Radio ad for a free video, Book of Mormon, or Bible (missionary follow-up)
 - Life-changing event (birth, death, wedding, etc.)

2. The Gospel of Jesus Christ

- Jesus Christ overcame physical death by his resurrection
- Therefore, all people will be resurrected
- To be saved from sin, we must use our free agency (free will), accept Christ and follow the Mormon faith
- Faith in Christ means serving him; repentance is total and permanent commitment to the Mormon gospel

- The outward expression of this is Mormon baptism
- With this “ordinance” we receive the companionship of the Holy Ghost
- By obeying God’s commandments as taught by the Mormon church, and by enduring to the end, we can be saved

3. The Restoration

- We must find and accept the truth
- By doing this, we learn that Christ founded his Church by revelation
- Revelation is continued today by "apostles" and "prophets"
- It was not always so; the first apostles were rejected and their priestly authority was completely lost

3. The Restoration (Cont.)

- For many centuries the institution known as “Christendom” was in reality an apostate church opposed to God and the truth
- Not until 1830, when Joseph Smith organized the Mormon church, was the true church of Christ restored to a lost world
- Priestly authority was re-established
- New scriptures were brought forth and ancient rituals were again performed

4. Eternal Progression

- Each one of us lived with God the Father and our "Heavenly Mother" (a wife of God the Father) in the eons before we were conceived by our earthly parents
- When we finally took on a physical body, we were given the opportunity to accept the Mormon plan, live obediently and finally progress to godhood ourselves
- Only temple-worthy Mormons can become gods

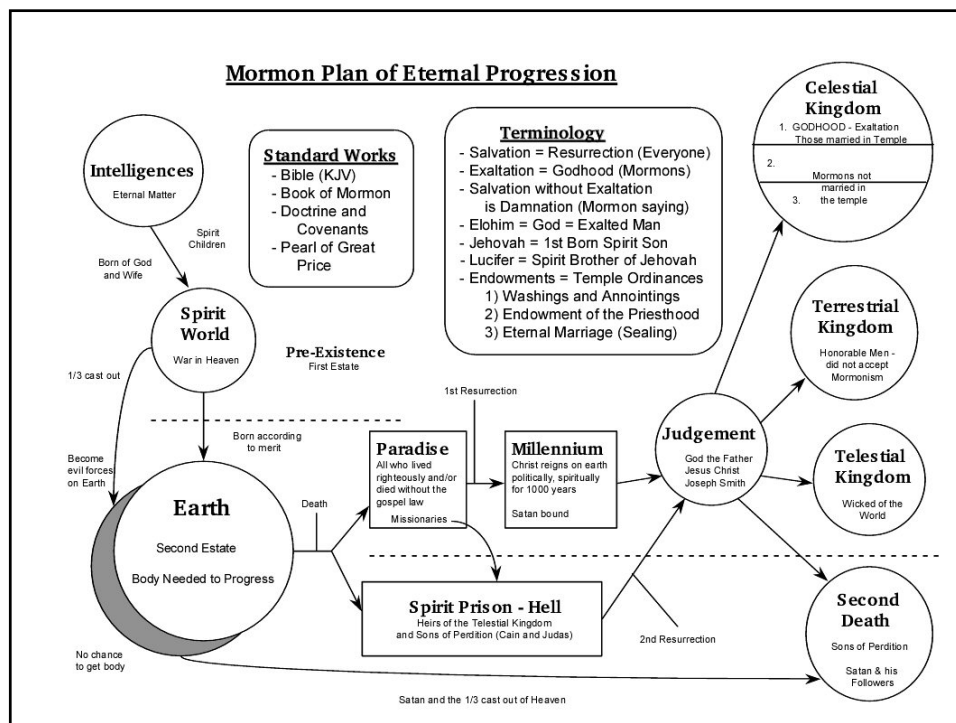
4. Eternal Progression (Cont.)

- Non-Mormons and those who fall short of the ideal do not return to God the Father
- Genealogy and proxy-work for the dead are necessary if they, too, are to be saved
- Families can thus be “for ever”
- Chastity and obedience to such rules as the “Word of Wisdom” are also necessary for eventual godhood

6. Membership in the Kingdom

- Jesus Christ is the Creator, Redeemer, and Judge
- Through obedience to his Mormon church, we can attain “exaltation”, or the highest level of salvation
- We become gods of our own worlds
- The Mormon church’s mission, therefore, is to help “perfect the saints, proclaim the gospel, and redeem the dead”

- We must heed the inspired guidance of Mormon leaders, follow the scriptures, perform the ordinances and serve
- Spreading the Mormon message is crucial to our own advancement, so we must cultivate a missionary spirit

The Catholic Response



- Faith and Reason are not diametrically opposed
- Three legs to stand on:
 - Bible (historical accuracy, God-inspired)
 - Tradition (Early Church Fathers, consistency)
 - Teaching Authority (Apostolic Succession)
